Special Category Rules

Macaroni & Cheese

1. Must be cooked from scratch onsite - No Blue Box!
2. There must be enough for six judges to sample. You can turn in either six individual servings, or one casserole-style.
3. You can use any ingredient except seafood - we don't want to have to worry about food allergies.
4. Macaroni & Cheese can be presented in any reasonably-sized tray, with open garnish.

Dessert

1. Components may be prepared in advance, though we encourage teams to cook their dessert onsite.
2. The final dessert product must be assembled onsite.
3. There must be enough for six judges to sample, in six individual pieces. e.g. Cakes must be cut.
4. Dessert can be presented in any reasonably-sized tray, with open garnish.
