### QUIET HOURS

The Market is a residential area.

From **10:00PM to 6:00AM**, quiet hours will be enforced.

This means that **GENERATORS ARE NOT ALLOWED!**

Please note on the registration form if you require power for your pit so that arrangements can be made with the Market.

### IMPORTANT NOTICE OF SET-UP TIMES

To allow the Market vendors adequate time to pack up and leave before our event, load-in and set-up will begin at 6:00PM on Saturday, March 29.

**EARLY ARRIVALS WILL NOT BE ACCOMMODATED!**

Registered teams will be sent detailed information about load-in and set-up procedure.

### FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

Each team **MUST** have

– at a minimum –

a 2A 40BC rated extinguisher (3A 40BC preferred).

The extinguisher must have been inspected or purchased within the last 12 months (proof of inspection or purchase is required). The Fire Department **WILL** inspect each team's area.
